Multiplication and division – solve missing number problems, integer scaling problems (Y4).

Fractions – Count up and down in tenths/hundredths (Y4), recognise fractions from a set of objects, Equivalent fractions with small denominators, add and subtract fractions, compare, and order fractions. Divide numbers by 10 and 100 (Y4)

Measurement – Length, mass, volume, and capacity Measure perimeter of 2D shapes. Find area of rectilinear shapes (Y4).

- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object
- Find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.
